19 pages, 8 plates. During the excavation at Gordion in Turkey, a hoard of 117 Tetradrachms were found in a pot buried under the foundation of a house. This was buried by a wealthy merchant some time after 218 BC which is the latest dating on one of the coins. Most of the coins are from the successors of Alexander the Great. The plates present both sides.

OLD COINS OF CHINA by Holger Jorgensen
6 pages, illustrated with 29 plates. Starts with the and spade issues of 700 BC and the Bronze holed issues of the Ch'in, Han, Three Kingdom, Chou, and later issues up to the Manchu Dynasty.
